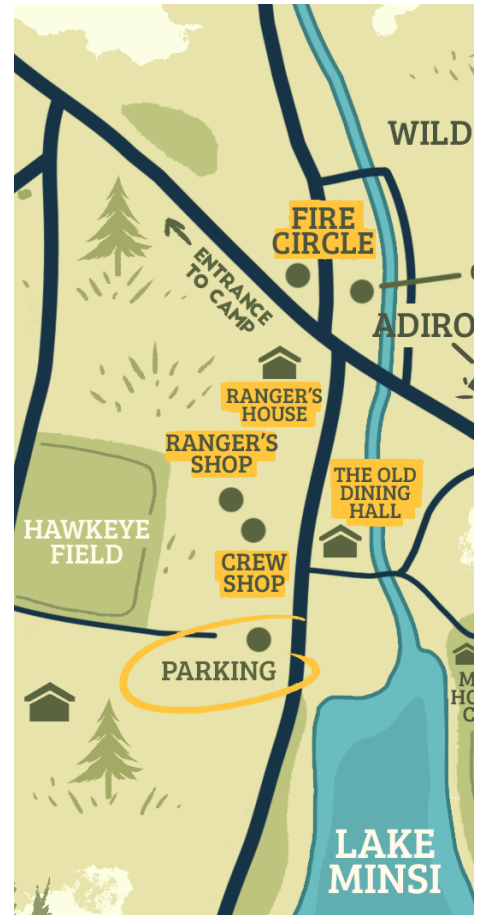
CAMP TREXLER SUNDAY CHECK IN

Below is a handy guide for you to follow as you come to Camp on the Sunday of your Week of Camp! For the comfort and safety of all Troops coming in on Sunday afternoon, including your own, we ask that the following procedures be adhered to.

Sunday Check In - 1pm

Check in begins at 1:00 P.M. For safety reasons, we ask that your unit not enter camp past the lower parking lot before this time.

- **Troop Trailers:** Troops who have trailers may drop them off at their site prior to 12:00 P.M. No other vehicles are allowed up to the campsite until their respective troop has checked in with the Camp Director.
- **Parking:** Parking will be at our Camp's lower Lot. Across from Lake Minsi. As you enter camp, pass by the Pool, head down the hill. Once you get to our Ranger's house, make a right. You'll pass our Old Dining Hall, our Ranger Shops, and you'll be able to park on the right.
- **Cars:** Please pack just a few vehicles with the gear for your unit. Not every vehicle associated with your unit, and not every parent will be able to drive into your Troop's site. Otherwise it would be a chaotic traffic nightmare. Your Troop will walk to your site with our Staff as your gear is dropped off by your Troop vehicle. This is an opportunity for your unit to find out how to get to your site.
- **Camp Director Check In:** Once you get your site guide, they'll bring your leader over to talk to our Camp Director so that you can confirm your Troop's arrival to Camp. Here you'll get your Check-In packet, and your Troop's Buddy Tags



Site Guides - 1pm

At 1:00 P.M. you will be assigned a member of the Staff to act as your Site Guide. The Site Guide will walk you through the check in process. Units will visit their site, drop off any gear they may be carrying (or in their troop vehicle). Gear should not be fully unpacked at this

time/set up in tents, just placed in the site. From there, our staff will guide you to a few locations/check in stations.

- Troop Photos
- Dining Hall Orientation
- Health Lodge Check In
- All units will end their check in at the Waterfront for orientation/Swim Tests (swimsuits should be brought on the Check In Process if your scouts are taking the swim test)

Notes -

- Colors is at 6pm, the rest of the week, Colors is normally 5:45.
- Scouts and Leaders should arrive at camp wearing the proper BSA Field Uniform;
- The Scoutmaster should have all medical forms, rosters, and prescription medications.
- Check in is different at every camp, we appreciate your cooperation as we welcome hundreds of Campers each week.
