NEW Locations - Listed here you'll find the updated locations for 2021.

CAMP OFFICE - **Now Located: Across from the Health Lodge in the "Old Trading Post Building"** - We've converted this into the new Camp Office Building. Funny enough this *used* to be the office many years ago. As a permanent Camp Office, we will no longer need to spend precious time setting up/tearing down the Office every year as we had to when it was hosted in Memorial Lodge. Our management team is excited to have a dedicated space for operational practices year round. ***The Candy/Snack Counter can still be found here on the back porch as it's been.***

TRADING POST - **Now Located: Dining Hall Basement** - We've converted the basement of the Dining Hall to a makeshift temporary Trading Post for 2021, part COVID measures, part restructuring of areas for future use, we'll be hosting our Trading Post beneath the Dining Hall this summer. You can access this from the front Dining Hall Porch, or from the back of the Dining Hall.

- *The Candy/Snack Counter will still be at the location on the Porch of the old Trading Post/Current Camp Office.* Scouts looking for a snack or slushie will still be able to easily access this here on the porch of the Camp Office.

NEW Program Area Locations - Listed here you'll find the updated areas for 2021.

AREA 7 - **Now Located: Memorial Cabin** - Area 7 is our Camp's approach to earning Eagle Required Badges, and badges that are typically best suited for a classroom setting. This was previously hosted in the old barn section of the Old Dining Hall. Currently undergoing repairs,

we've moved Area 7 to Memorial Cabin. Scouts taking any Area 7 Merit Badges should report here.

Area 7 Badges - Archeology, American Heritage, Citizenship in the Nation/World, Communication, Law, Scouting Heritage

CRIME & SAFETY - Now Located: Athletics Field Pavilion - Crime and Safety is an area where Scouts can learn about Crime Prevention and Safety related programs. This Program area will be held in our Athletics Field Pavilion, Scout taking any of these badges should report here for their badge classes.

Crime & Safety Badges - Crime Prevention, Fire Safety, Safety, Traffic Safety

ECON/SENTR - Now Located: Nature Lodge - Our *ECON - Nature, Science, Technology Center* now hosts what was previously known as *SENTR* (formerly in the Cabin by the waterfront). Scouts taking any ECON or formerly *SENTR* badges should head to the Nature Lodge up near Middle Creek Field.

ECON Badges - Astronomy, Bird Study, Environmental Science, Fish & Wildlife Management, Forestry, Insect Study, Mammal Study, Nature, Oceanography, Plant Science, Reptile & Amphibian Study, Weather, Chemistry, Space Exploration

Music & Arts - Now Located: Windy Knob Cabin - Music and Arts will now be hosted at Windy Knob Cabin. Any Scouts taking Music and Arts badges should report here.

Music and Arts Badges - Art, Sculpting, Moviemaking, Music, Photography, Theater

Trades and Skills - Now Located: Rangers Shop/Crew Shop - Trades and Skills (formerly TOC) will now be hosted at the Ranger's Shops. Any Scouts taking T&S badges should report here.

Trades and Skills Badges - Automotive Maintenance/Farm Mechanics, Plumbing, Metalworking, Welding

HEALTH LODGE (Badges) - Now Located: Health Lodge - While the location of the Health Lodge as a whole has not changed, we've moved Emergency Preparedness and First Aid to the Health Lodge! Meet here for both those badges.

Regular Program Area Locations - Listed here you'll find the areas that are remaining in their regular locations at Camp.

COPE - Located: COPE Course - COPE and all COPE events will be located up at our COPE Course up near Middle Creek Field/Hawkeye Field.

COPE Badges - Climbing, Search and Rescue

HANDICRAFT - Located: Handicraft Pavilion - Handicraft can be found across from the Health Lodge at the Handicraft Pavilion.

Handicraft Badges - Home Repairs, Pottery, Leatherwork, Textiles, Woodcarving, Painting, Inventing, Basketry

SCOUTCRAFT - Located: Scoutcraft Pavilion - Scoutcraft can be found past the Healthlodge/Beck Pavilion and before Wilderness Campsite.

Scoutcraft Badges - Camping, Cooking, Indian Lore, Fishing, Wilderness Survival, Pioneering, Exploration

SHOOTING SPORTS - Located: Ranges - Each badge can be found at their respective Ranges.

Shooting Sports Badges - Archery, Rifle, Shotgun

Waterfront - Located: Lake Trexler - Hosted at Lake Trexler (not lake Minsi), all aquatics badges will meet here. (Fishing Merit Badge is not located here - that's at Scoutcraft)

Waterfront Badges - Canoeing, Kayaking, Lifesaving, Rowing, Swimming

We realize there are quite a few location changes this summer, but as we approached some COVID procedures, and general quality of life adjustments for our Staff/Campers, we think we're on track to generate some really cool experiences for our Scouts/Campers this summer, and these changes will be a big part of our plan.

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
